## "And just as you want men to do to you, you also do to them likewise"



Furthermore, love every man as yourself – that is, do not wish him anything that you would not wish for yourself; think, feel for him just as you would think and feel for your own self; do not wish to see in him anything that you that you do not wish to see in yourself; do not let your memory keep in it any evil caused to you by others, in the same way as you would wish that the evil done by yourself should be forgotten by others; do not intentionally imagine either in yourself or in another anything guilty or impure; believe others to be as wellintentioned as yourself, in general, if you do not see clearly that they are evilly disposed; do unto them as you would to yourself, or even do not do unto them as you would not do unto yourself, and then you will see what you will obtain in your heart - what peace, what blessedness! You will be in paradise before reaching it - that is, before the paradise in heaven you will be in paradise on earth. 'The kingdom of God is within you,' says the Lord. 'He that dwells in love,' teaches the Apostle, 'dwells in God and God in him.'" (St. John of Kronsdadt, My Life in Christ).




# **EPISTLE READING**: St. Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians 6:16-18; 7:1
